Subject:- Award of three "Class of 1969" Alumni Scholarships and three "Amrit Kaur Scholarships" to undergraduate students of B.E (Chem. Engg. & Tech.) w/ Rs. 2000/- p.m. each for 10 months for the year 2020-2021.

Dear Sir/Madam,

The Senate vide Para(1) dated 24.2.1997, Para (1) dated 07.10.1997, Senate (iii) dated 30.7.1999 & Para 29 dated 17.08.2015 and senate vide para (1) dated 18.07.2015 and para (ii) dated 25.03.2001 and accepted the donation of US \$ 1204 (Rs. 12,500/-) & 1774 (Rs. 61075/-), \$1530 (Rs. 64088/-) and US \$ 802 (Rs. 30279/-) respectively from Dr. Bhavender Pal Sharma, USA on behalf of Class 1969. Now, the Senate vide para 39 dated 31.07.2016 has accepted an additional donation of Rs. 9,83,682/- made by Dr. Bhavender Pal Sharma, USA on behalf of Class 1969 batch, and approved the same in terms and conditions.

Applications of eligible students are invited for the award of Six (06) Scholarships above to the undergraduate students of B.E (Chem. Engg. & Tech.) Panjab University, Chandigarh. The amended rules for the award are given below:-

1. Three scholarship be known as "Class of 1969 Alumni scholarships" and three of them be known as "Amrit Kaur Scholarship"
2. Six scholarships be paid two each to undergraduate classes of B.E (Chem. Engg. & Tech.) including those with the combined MBA program of University of Chiba (UoC) & Tech. (UoCET) on merit basis. Each class is of Rs. 2000/- p.m. each for 10 months.
3. The applicant must have cleared all the undergraduate last semester examination with at least 60% marks. There should be no backlog from the immediate past examination. Student's family income should be no more than 10/- lakh per year.
4. The applicant should be willing to perform at least 40 hours of voluntary work in the college. A few examples are as follows but the student is free to undertake any other work in the college:
 - a. Volunteer work at the UoCET library
 - b. Volunteer tutoring of KIn worker's children in the University
 - c. Volunteer work at the University Library
 - d. Volunteer work for activities such as cleaning up of the campus
 - e. Volunteer work at the sector 29 office in the UoCET
 - f. Tutoring of one or more children from the poor families such as the orphan school etc.
 - g. Any service to be performed in the college.
5. The student has to complete the voluntary work by Feb 28. A one page summary of the volunteer work needs to be submitted to In-charge Schools Alumni & Ex-student's Affairs (sna.ina7136@gmail.com) with a copy to the UoCET Chairperson at UoCET 219, Panjab University, Chandigarh by March 16 of every year.
6. Upon timely submission of the volunteer work summary, the scholarship amount will be released to the Class of 1969 Alumni Scholarship committee by March 31.
7. The recipient of this scholarship will be free to accept any other scholarship.
8. Prof. S.K. Sharma is nominated to be a representative on the scholarship committee.
9. The scholarships will be awarded on the recommendation of the committee constituted by the Vice-Chancellor.

You are requested to forward the application of each eligible student recommended by the Administrative Committee of the department in view of the conditions mentioned above positively by 26.5.2021
